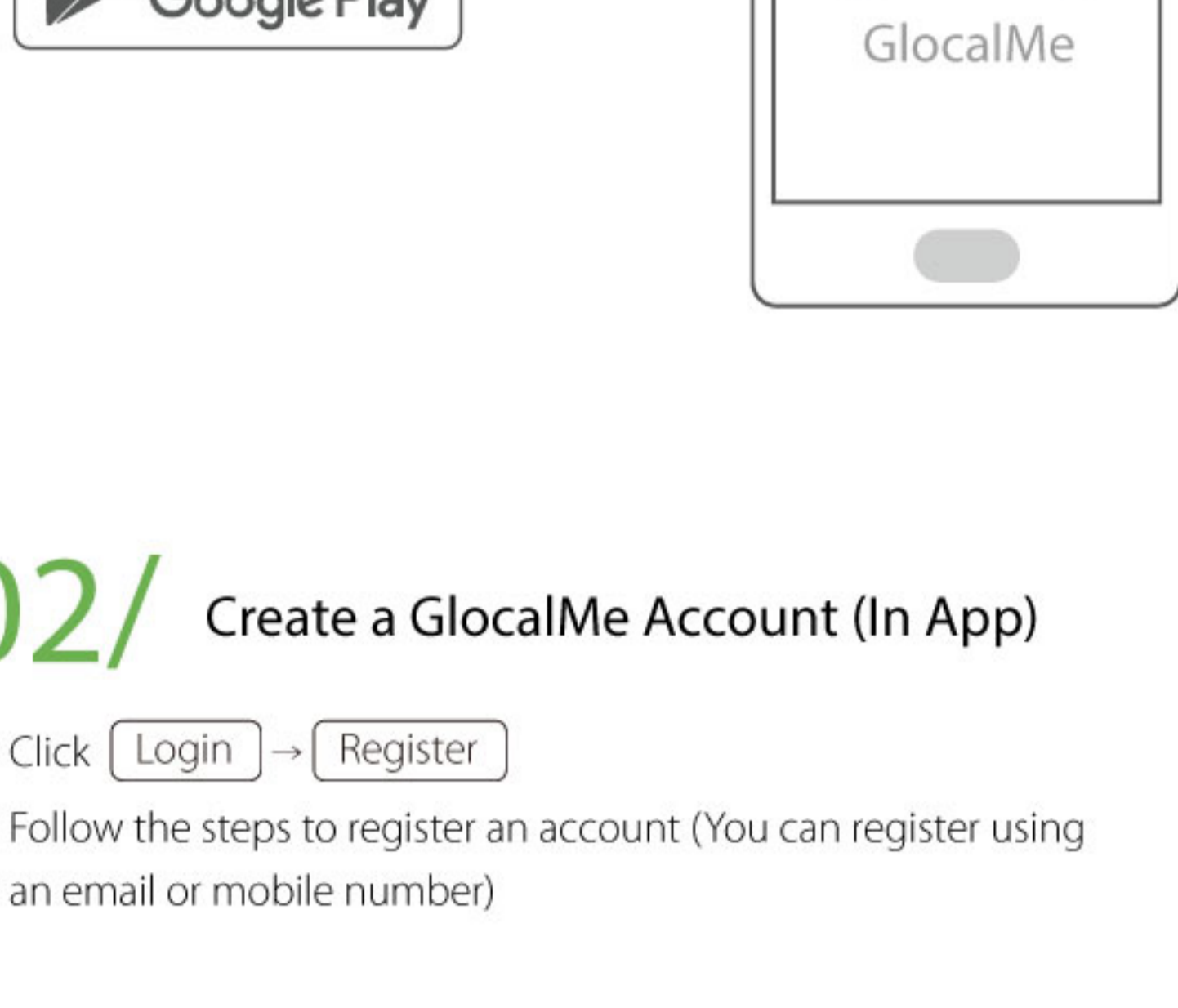

【How To Use GlocalMe Cloud SIM Service?】 (Highly Recommended)

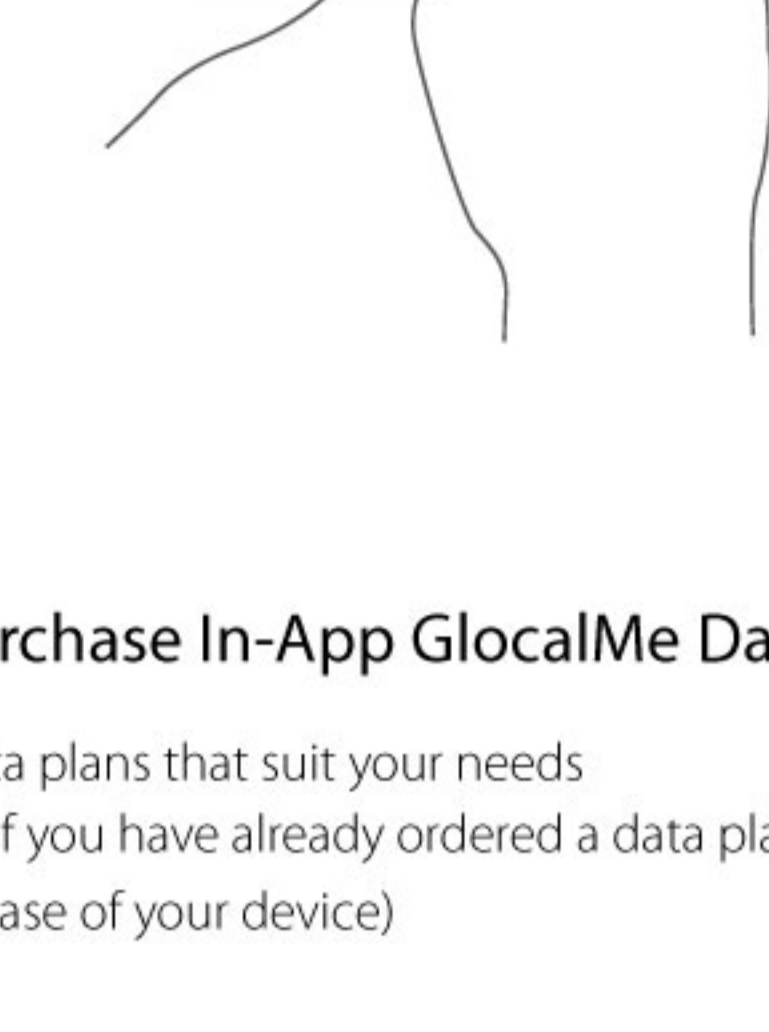
01/ Download GlocalMe APP

- Download and install GlocalMe app on your mobile phone



02/ Create a GlocalMe Account (In App)

- Click **Login** → **Register**
- Follow the steps to register an account (You can register using an email or mobile number)



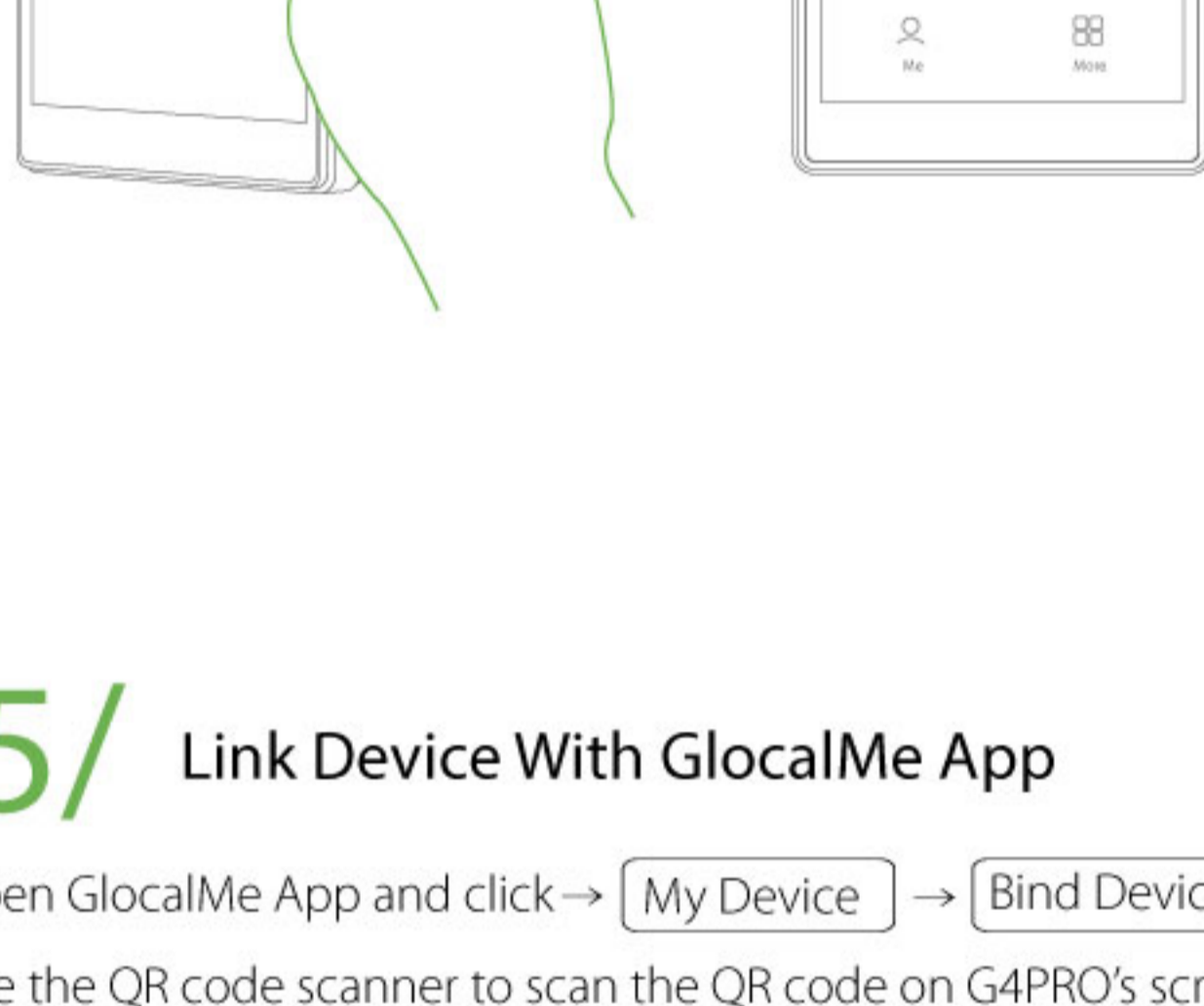
03/ Purchase In-App GlocalMe Data Plans

- Choose the data plans that suit your needs (Skip this step if you have already ordered a data plan with the purchase of your device)



04/ Turn On G4PRO

- Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds (if you cannot turn on the new G4PRO, please charge the device and wait for device to be fully charged)



05/ Link Device With GlocalMe App

- Open GlocalMe App and click → **My Device** → **Bind Device**
- Use the QR code scanner to scan the QR code on G4PRO's screen



06/ Connect To Wi-Fi

- Find the Wi-Fi network name and password on the screen of G4PRO
- On your mobile device(s) under Wi-Fi settings search for the network and connect



【How To Use A Physical SIM Card?】

(G4PRO is default to run on Cloud SIM services, but it also supports the use of local SIM cards)

01/ Insert The SIM Card

- Turn off your device and open the SIM card tray with a pin and insert the SIM card as shown in the picture below
- You can insert 1 Nano SIM and 1 TR card



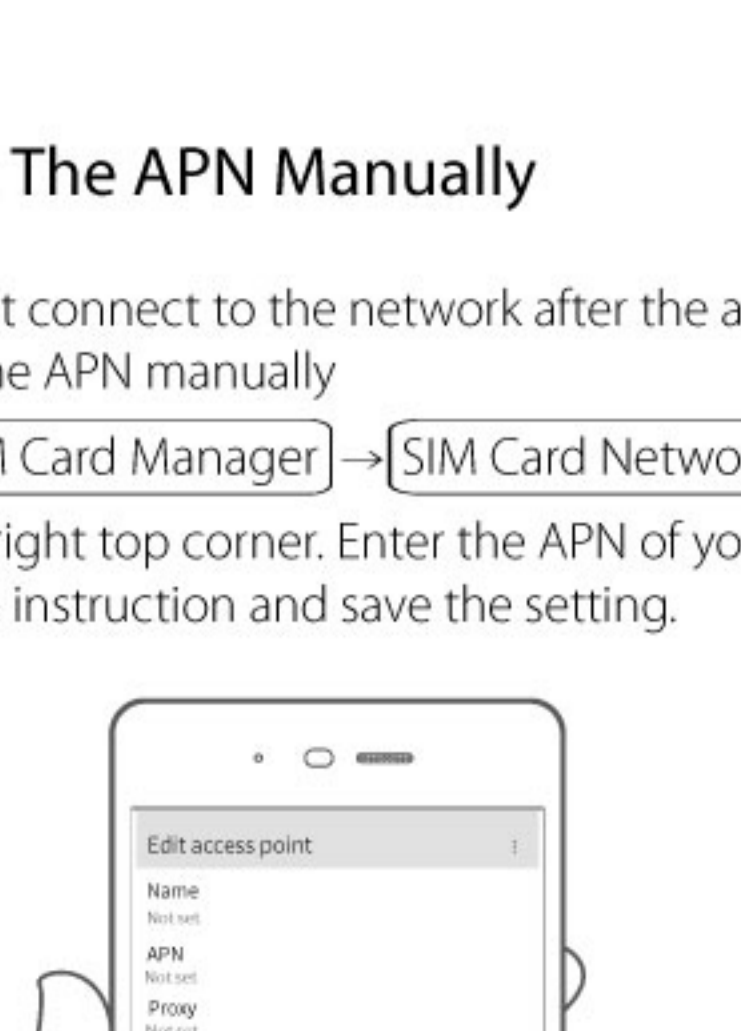
02/ Unlock SIM Card (If PIN protected)

- If SIM card is PIN protected, please unlock it on your phone by entering your PIN number. Once unlocked, you can insert into your G4PRO device.



03/ Select The SIM Card

- **More** → **SIM Card Manager** enable the SIM card network you need to use



04/ Set The APN Manually

- If you still cannot connect to the network after the above steps, you must add the APN manually
- **More** → **SIM Card Manager** → **SIM Card Network Settings** → **APN**

Click "+" on the right top corner. Enter the APN of your SIM card provider according to the instruction and save the setting.
